Primary Functions

Perform a variety of highly skilled maintenance work to maintain and repair structures, electrical systems and hydraulic and pneumatic equipment. Maintenance personnel are required to perform a broad range of tasks throughout the facility. Work requirements differ day to day, performed on an as needed basis, working indoors and outdoors.

Duties and Overall Responsibilities

- Perform highly skilled maintenance work to maintain and repair structures, electrical systems and hydraulic and pneumatic equipment
- Program or edit Programmable Logic Controllers (PLC)
- Assist Maintenance Technician/Journeyman as needed
- Perform other duties as assigned

Physical Requirements

The physical requirements for this position require continuous standing and intermittent walking, bending, sitting, lifting up to 50 lbs. The Maintenance Technician should have the physical and mental ability to perform the above necessary job functions while maintaining an exemplary safety record.

Skills and Experience

- Basic math skills – counting, adding, subtracting, multiplication, division
- In-depth knowledge of various trades
- At least one year experience in a manufacturing environment

Educational Requirements

- One to three years electrical or mechanical trades training
